

## **2021 BHPW Association Rules and Regulations**

- 1. Must be between 17-25 years old at the time of the Miss He Sapa Win Pageant.
- 2. Must be currently enrolled in high school or college.
- 3. Must be of Native American decent and provide proof if needed.
- 4. Must be drug and alcohol free.
- 5. Must have never been married or given birth.
- 6. Must have basic knowledge of your Tribe.
- 7. Must be available for crowning, ceremonies, publicity, parades, gatherings, etc.
- 8. Must wear dance regalia for the entire Black Hills Pow Wow.
- 9. Must be available to provide a picture for publicity.

Must have participated in Native American dance at least one year.

- 10. Must provide transportation to events.
- 11. The titleholder will be responsible for the care, maintenance, and safekeeping of the crown and sash throughout the year.
- 12. It is mandatory for the titleholder who is crowned to represent the BHPW at all local pow wows.
- 13. Have strong public speaking skills as needed for public speaking.
- 14. Will hold only the "Miss He Sapa Win" title until the reign is over.
- 15. Must attend the Black Hills Powwow and crown successor.
- 16. Must be respectful of her title and conduct herself respectfully in the public eye and on social media.
- 17. You may not have previously served as Miss He Sapa Win.

# Miss He Sapa Win

# Responsibilities:

- If selected, Miss He Sapa Win, will be selected to perform duties that best represent the Black Hills Powwow, as well as serving as a positive role model to all.
- As an emerging leader in the local community, she will be expected to participate fully in the current and upcoming years' Black Hills Powwow, including all local powwows.
- Wearing her regalia for the entire powwow.
- Welcoming all powwow guests by speaking at each grand entry and where she is needed.
- Dance in all intertribals.
- Attend the Black Hills Powwow and assist in crowning her successor.
- Inform the BHPW Members if she plans on doing a special or giveaway at the powwow (not required).
- Throughout the year, the titleholder will be expected to uphold the highest standards of leadership, cultural and community involvement.
- She will be expected to represent the Black Hills Powwow at a minimum of six powwows available for crowning, ceremonies, publicity, parades, and any other Indigenous gathering as called upon.

### SELECTION PROCESS & NOTIFICATION: 2021 Miss He Sapa Win will be named on Saturday, October 9, 2021, after 7:00PM Grand Entry.

Our selection committee will select the titleholder based upon each applicant's:

- Application written statements and reference letters
- Public Speaking and Interview
- Essay
- Presentation of Regalia
- Dance Participation
